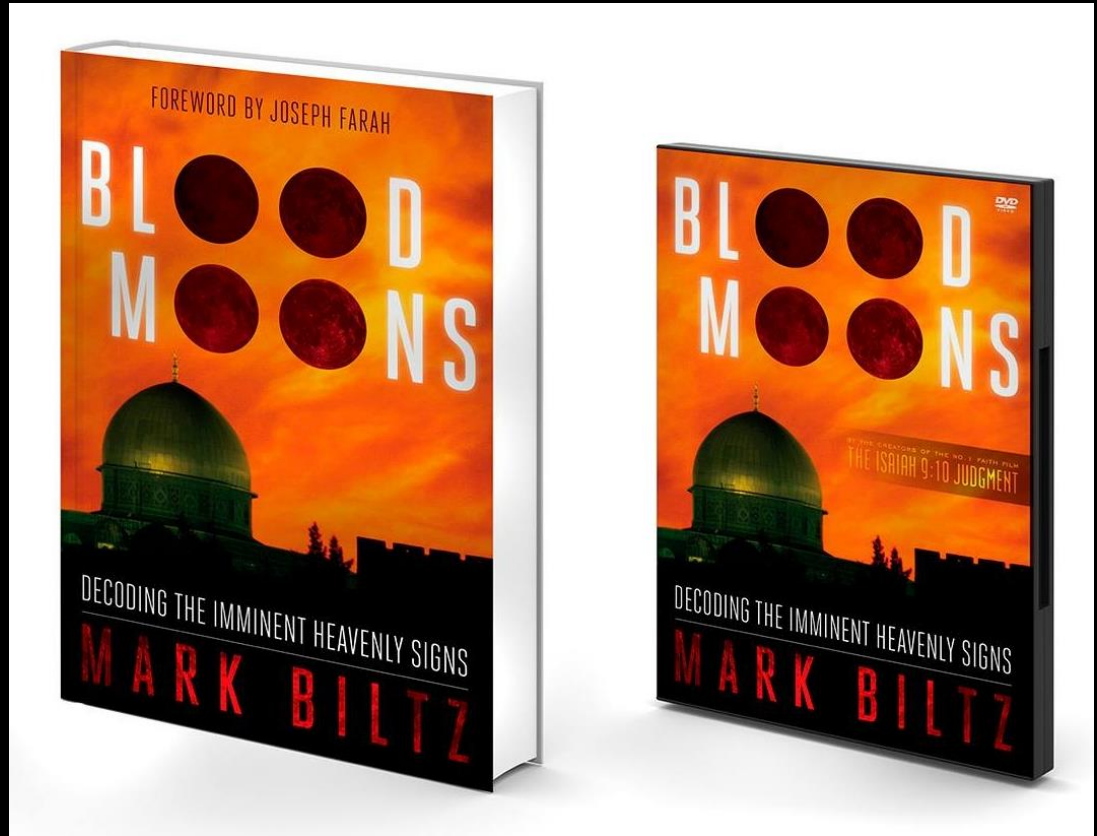
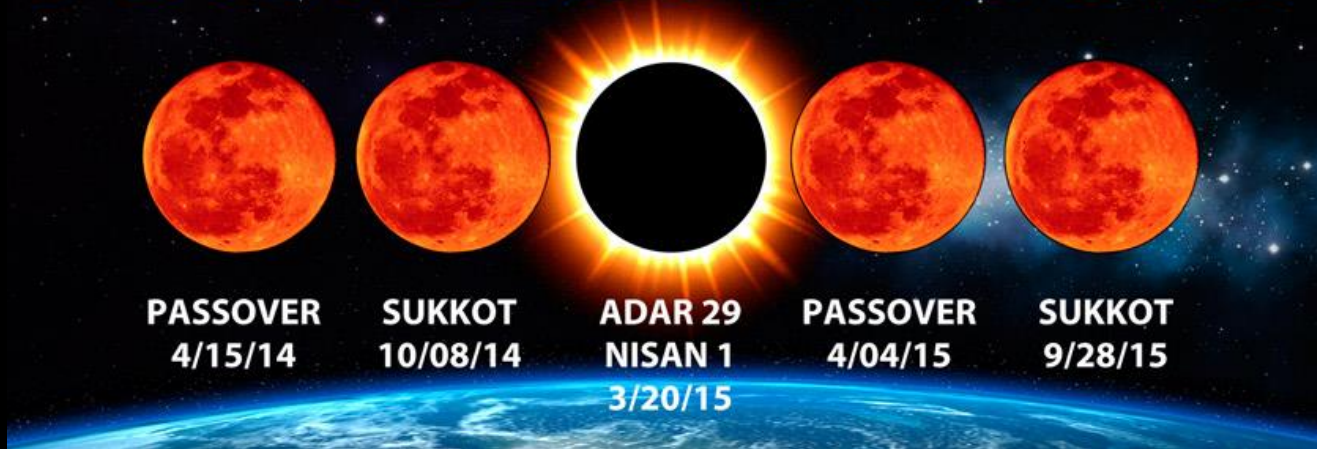

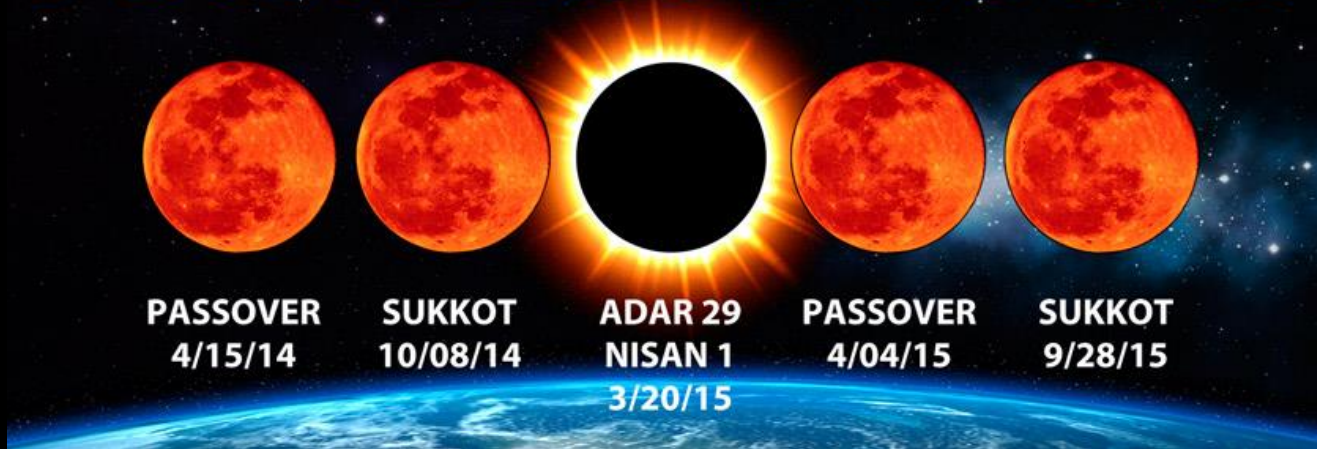


THE COMING FOUR BLOOD MOONS



- The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD. Joel 2.31, also quoted by Peter in Acts 2.20.
- I watched as he opened the sixth seal. There was a great earthquake. The sun turned black like sackcloth made of goat hair, the whole moon turned blood red. Revelation 6.12.

THE COMING FOUR BLOOD MOONS



This coming occurrence of four lunar eclipses on biblical feast days is called a lunar tetrad and it's very rare. It happened once in the 15th century after Jews were expelled from Spain and Portugal, 1493-1494. It did not happen at all in the 16th, 17th, 18th, or 19th centuries. It happened twice in the 20th century, right after Israel's War of Independence and again after Israel's Six Days War. It will happen only once in the 21st century: 2014 and 2015.

What does this sign mean? "Put it in your own theological pipe and smoke it," Pastor Mark Biltz, El Shaddai Ministries, Tacoma, WA, who discovered it. The sun and moon were created primarily as signs and for seasons, Genesis 1.14.

Bonus: Rabbi Judah ben Samuel's Prophecy about Jerusalem

1217

- Ben Samuel prophesied in 1217 that there would be 10 Jubilees for Jerusalem before Messiah comes.
- One Jubilee is 50 years (Leviticus 25). It is the 50th year after seven times seven Sabbath years, the year in which each person should regain ownership of his or her land. So ten Jubilees is 500 years.
- For eight Jubilees, 400 years, Jerusalem would be under Muslim control, he said.
- For one Jubilee, 50 years, there would be confusion and Jerusalem would be a "no man's land."
- For the last Jubilee, 50 years, Jews would be in control of Jerusalem. Then the Messianic Age would arrive.

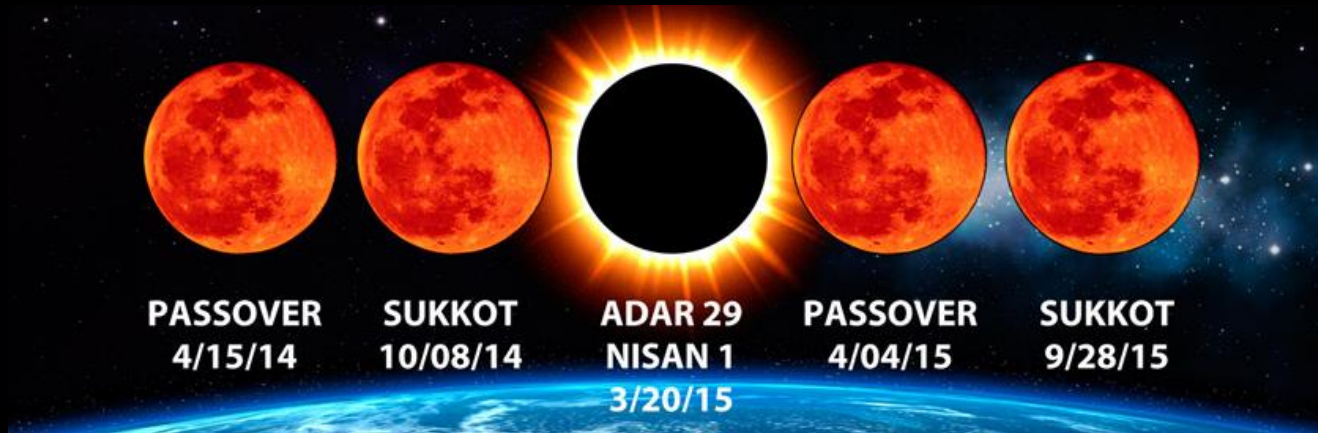
